(i) Proposals for “Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Diving at Work) Regulations 2005”

The draft proposals for Regulations prescribe the measures to be taken to safeguard the safety, health and welfare of persons at work engaged in diving operations coming within the scope of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 1989. The proposed Regulations are designed to impose requirements and prohibitions with respect to persons at work who “dive” as defined in Regulation 2(1). The Regulations are intended to apply, inshore and offshore, to “diving projects” as defined, subject to certain specified exceptions (Regulation 3).

The proposed Regulations, which are based partly on the British “Diving at Work Regulations 1997 (S.I. 1997/2776)”, are designed to modernise the law relating to this area of work, and to revoke and replace the Safety in Industry (Diving Operations) Regulations 1981 (S.I. No. 422 of 1981).

(ii) Proposals for “Code of Practice for Commercial Diving Projects Inland and Inshore”

The draft proposals for a Code of Practice are designed to give practical guidance on safe work in commercial diving projects inland and inshore on the observance of the requirements of the draft Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Diving at Work) Regulations 2005 (referred to in the draft Code as the “Diving Regulations”). In particular, guidance is given on how to comply with provisions that are set out in general terms in the Regulations. This draft Code of Practice, which is based partly on the Health and Safety Executive approved “Code of Practice for Commercial Diving Projects Inland and Inshore”, applies to all inland and inshore commercial diving projects. Separate Code(s) of Practice may be issued in future for other areas of commercial diving.
