HEALTH (IN-PATIENT CHARGES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2004.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations amend the Health (In-patient Charges) Regulations, 1987 and 2003 by raising the daily charges for in-patient services from €45.00 to €55.00 and by raising the maximum amount payable in any period of twelve consecutive months from €450 to €500. The usual exemptions, which include medical card holders and hardship provision shall continue to apply. The revised charge comes into effect on 1 January, 2005.

HEALTH (OUT-PATIENT CHARGES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2004.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation)

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the charge set out in the Health (Out-Patient Charges) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003. The charge is revised from €45.00 to €55.00 in respect of attendance at accident and emergency or casualty departments where the person concerned has not been referred by a medical practitioner. The charge shall not apply where such an attendance results in hospital admission. The usual exemptions, which include medical card holders and hardship provision shall continue to apply. The revised charge comes into effect on 1 January, 2005.

HEALTH SERVICES REGULATIONS 2005.

SUBSTANCES AND PREPARATIONS)
(MARKETING AND USE) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2004.

These Regulations transpose Directive 2003/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, Commission Directives 2004/21/EC, 2004/96/EC and 2004/98/EC.

Directive 2003/53/EC amends for the 26th time Council Directive 76/769/EEC relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations (nonylphenol, nonylphenol ethoxylate and cement).

Commission Directive 2004/21/EC of 24 February 2004, relates to restrictions on the marketing and use of “azo colourants” (thirteenth adaptation to technical progress of Council Directive 76/769/EEC).

Commission Directive 2004/96/EC of 27 September 2004 amends Council Directive 76/769/EEC regarding restrictions on the marketing and use of nickel.

Commission Directive 2004/98/EC of 30 September 2004, amending Council Directive 76/769/EEC regarding restrictions on the marketing and use of pentabromodiphenyl ether in aircraft emergency evacuation systems.

INFECTIOUS DISEASES (MAINTENANCE
ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 2005.

The effect of these Regulations is to provide as from 1st January 2005, for increases in the maximum rates of maintenance allowances payable to persons being treated for certain infectious diseases.

The infectious diseases for which maintenance allowances are payable are acute anterior poliomyelitis, diphtheria, dysentery, salmonellosis, tuberculosis, typhoid and paratyphoid fevers, typhus and viral haemorrhagic diseases (including lassa fever and marburg disease).
