NORWAY LOBSTER (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND
CONSERVATION) (No. 2) REGULATIONS 2005.

Prn A5/1131

These Regulations provide for the management regime for the Norway lobster fishery in ICES Area VI with effect from 8 July 2005. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, fishing in the specified area may not have or retain on board or land more than 2 tonnes of Norway lobster during the period from 1 July 2005 to 31 July 2005. Any other Irish sea-fishing boat fishing for Norway lobster, or a person on board such boat, fishing in the specified area may not have or retain on board or land more than 1 tonne of Norway lobster during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Norway lobster.

BASS FISHING CONSERVATION BYE-LAW No. 800 of
2005.

Prn A5/1155

The effect of this Bye-law is to impose a bag limit on anglers of two bass in any one period of 24 hours and to provide for a ban on angling for bass during the spawning season (15 May 2006 to 15 June 2006).
