TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on 23rd day of October 2004, one Mercedes motor lorry, bearing identification mark XXI 3907 was seized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141(1) of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 125 of the Finance Act 2001.

Your attention is drawn to the Provisions of Section 143 of the Finance Act 2001, which states as follows:

[5] *(1) A person who claims that anything seized as liable to forfeiture is not so liable (referred to in this Section as the "claimant") shall, within one month of the date of the notice of seizure or, where no such notice has been given to the claimant, within one month of the date of the seizure, give notice in writing of such claim to the Commissioners.*

(2) A notice under sub-section (1) shall specify the name and address of the claimant and, in the case of a claimant who is outside the State, the name and address of a Solicitor in the State who is authorised to accept service of any document required to be served on the claimant and to act on behalf of the claimant.

Any such claim should be directed to the Investigations & Prosecution Division, Áras Ailigh, Bridgend, Co. Donegal.
