CONTROL OF FISHING FOR SALMON ORDER 2005.

The Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources Mr. Pat the Cope Gallagher, T.D., has made the above Order.

This Order, which replaces the Control of Fishing for Salmon Order 1980 (as amended) and the Control of Fishing for Salmon by Drift Net (Kerry Fishery District) Order 1982 (as amended), authorises the issue of commercial salmon fishing licences by Regional Fisheries Boards and prescribes the criteria under which those licences may be issued. The Order also revises the maximum numbers of commercial licences which may be issued by Regional Boards.

DEEP SEA FISHING ALLOCATIONS AND ORANGE ROUGHY PROTECTION AREAS REGULATIONS 2005.

HORSE MACKEREL (FISHERIES AND MANAGEMENT CONSERVATION) REGULATIONS 2005.

The effect of these Regulations is to prohibit fishing for, transhipment or having on board horse mackerel by Irish sea-fishing boats, in ICES sub-areas VI, VII, and XIV, with effect from 28 February 2005.

HORSE MACKEREL (LICENCING) REGULATIONS 2005.

These Regulations provide for a licensing regime for the fishing of horse mackerel in ICES areas VI, VII, XII and XIV and divisions IIa (Community waters), North Sea (Community waters) IVa, Vb (Community waters), VIIIa, b, d and e for boats of more than 19.81 metres (65 feet) in length, with effect from 1 March 2005.
