TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on 26th August 2005, one Citroen Saxo motor vehicle, bearing identification mark TIW 4283 was seized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141(1) of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 139(6) of the Finance Act 1992.
