MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCES (INCREASED

The effect of these Regulations is to increase, in respect of the week commencing 5th December, 2005, the maximum weekly rate of maintenance allowance payable under Section 44 of the Health Act 1947 by a sum equal to one hundred per cent of that amount or €30.00, whichever, is the greater sum.

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (COSMETIC PRODUCTS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2005.

The purpose of the Regulations is to update the law in relation to the manufacture, marketing and sale of cosmetic products by the implementation of Commission Directives 2005/9/EC and 2005/42/EC.

The Regulations provide for: (a) the prohibition of the use of certain substances as fragrances in cosmetic products; (b) the removal of certain colouring agents from the list of such agents permitted for use in cosmetic products; (c) a widening of the scope of use of a preservative used in cosmetic products; (d) an addition to the list of ultraviolet filters which cosmetic products may contain; (e) the correction of an error which has come to light since publication of the principal Regulations.

TO WHOM IT CONCERNS
