**SEA FISHERIES (WEIGHING PROCEDURES FOR
HERRING, MACKEREL AND HORSE MACKEREL)
(No. 3) REGULATIONS 2005.**

These Regulations transpose into Irish law the provisions of point 3 of the Annex of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1300/2005 which establishes weighing procedures for fishing vessels landing more than 10 tonnes of herring, mackerel or horse mackerel per landing. Masters or other persons in charge of the Irish or foreign sea-fishing boats in question will be required to give 4 hours advance notification of entry into ports of landing to Sea Fisheries Protection Officers, Landings in excess of 10 tonnes shall only be permitted in designated ports.

**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (SATELLITE-BASED
VESSEL MONITORING SYSTEMS) REGULATIONS 2005.**

These Regulations provide in Irish law for the provisions of Commission Regulation (EC) No. 2244/03 of 18 December 2003 laying down detailed provisions regarding satellite-based Vessel Monitoring Systems. These Regulations require that sea fishing boats exceeding 15 metres in overall length have satellite based vessel monitoring systems installed. These Regulations do not apply to sea fishing boats used exclusively for aquaculture purposes and operating exclusively inside the baselines.

**MACKEREL (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND
