## COMMISSION FOR TAXI REGULATION

S.I. No. 651 of 2005

### TAXI REGULATION ACT 2003 (FEES AND LICENSING) REGULATIONS 2005

The Commissioner for Taxi Regulation has made Regulations under the Taxi Regulation Act 2003 entitled above.

These Regulations confirm the existing fees payable for the grant, continuation in force or renewal of licences in respect of small public service vehicles. By virtue of section 50(1) of the Taxi Regulation Act 2003, these Regulations allow licence fees to accrue to the Commission for Taxi Regulation.

These Regulations also allow the Commission for Taxi Regulation to grant licences in respect of small public service vehicles and their drivers. They further provide that licensing authorities, other than the Commission, who engage in the licensing of small public service vehicles may continue to do so.

In addition, these Regulations revoke the power of local authorities to fix maximum taxi fares. This is now the function of the Commission for Taxi Regulation under the provisions of section 42 of the Taxi Regulation Act 2003.

## TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on 8th day of August 2005, one Audi 100 motor vehicle, bearing identification mark UJI 7405 was seized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141(1) of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 139(6) of the Finance Act 1992.

Your attention is drawn to the Provisions of Section 143 of the Finance Act 2001 which states as follows:

*(1) A person who claims that anything seized as liable to forfeiture is not so liable (referred to in this Section as the "claimant") shall, within one month of the date of the notice of seizure or, where no such notice has been given to the claimant, within one month of the date of the seizure, give notice in writing of such claim to the Commissioners.*

*(2) A notice under sub-section (1) shall specify the name and address of the claimant and, in the case of a claimant who is outside the State, the name and address of a Solicitor in the State who is authorised to accept service of any document required to be served on the claimant and to act on behalf of the claimant.*
