No. 523 of 2005) and (2) Employment Regulation Order (Contract Cleaning (excluding the City and County of Dublin) Joint Labour Committee), 2005 (S.I. No. 524 of 2005). These Orders are effective from 2nd September, 2005 and fix the statutory minimum rates of pay and statutory conditions of employment of workers in relation to whom the Committee operate.

Notices containing details of the Order may be had from the Labour Court on application. **CELTIC SEA HERRING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT

These Regulations allow Irish sea-fishing boats to land or tranship herring caught in the Celtic Sea, or that part of the exclusive fishery limits of the State that lies south of the line of latitude of 52°30' North, from 2 September 2005, provided that the herring does not exceed 5% by weight of the total catch of quota species landed or transhipped on any occasion.
