**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (PROTECTION OF  
 EMPLOYEES) (PART-TIME WORKERS) REGULATIONS  
 2005.**

The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, Mr. Micheál Martin TD, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made the above Regulations.

These Regulations remove the provisions in the Labour Services Act 1987 (No. 15 of 1987) that an employee must work not less than 18 hours a week for FÁS before being entitled to vote in Worker Director Election, or to be eligible to be nominated as a candidate at the Elections. This is to give full effect to Section 9 of the Protection of Employees (Part-Time Work) Act 2001 (No. 45 of 2001), which outlaws the discrimination of part-time workers.
