 REGULATIONS 2006.**

The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, Mr. Micheál Martin, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made Regulations introducing a ban on the sale, supply or transfer of technical advice, assistance or training related to military activities against certain persons and entities associated with Usama bin Laden, the Al-Qaida Network and the Taliban. These Regulations also revoke previous Regulations concerning trade with Afghanistan and give effect to Council Regulation (EC) No. 881/2002 of 27 May 2002.
