CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD

The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment has made  
the following Statutory Instruments:

1. Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulations 2006;
2. European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by  
Road) (ADR Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2006;
3. Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Act 1998  
(Appointment of Competent Authorities) Order 2006; and

These Statutory Instruments transpose into Irish law the  
provisions of Directives 2004/111/EC (adapting for the fifth time  
to technical progress Council Directive 94/55/EC on the  
approximation of the laws of the Member States with regard  
to the transport of dangerous goods by road) and 2004/112/EC  
(adapting to technical progress Council Directive 95/50/EC on  
uniform procedures for checks on the transport of dangerous  
goods by road), set out the necessary competent authorities, and  
set down the fees payable to these competent authorities for the  
functions performed by them under the Regulations.

The new Directives give effect to the 2005 changes to the  
technical Annexes of the European Agreement concerning the  
International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR)  
which was made under the auspices of the United Nations  
Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE).
