EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (FOODSTUFFS INTENDED FOR PARTICULAR NUTRITIONAL USES) REGULATIONS 2006.

*(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).*

These Regulations concern foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses. They revoke the European Communities (Foodstuffs Intended for Particular Nutritional Uses) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 66 of 2005) and bring into effect new Regulations. These Regulations give further effect to Council Directive 89/398/EEC of 3 May 1989 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses, as amended by Directive 96/84/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 December 1996, and Directive 1999/41/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 June 1999, and give further effect to Commission Directive 2001/15/EC of 15 February 2001, as amended by Commission Directive 2004/5/EC of 20 January 2004.

These Regulations give effect to Commission Directive 2006/34/EC of 21 March 2006 amending the Annex to Directive 2001/15/EC as regards the inclusion of certain substances.

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Foodstuffs Intended for Particular Nutritional Uses) Regulations 2006.

3. “That the Liquidator’s remuneration shall be fixed by reference to the time given by him as a responsible Insolvency Practitioner, and his staff, in attending to matters arising in the winding up and he shall be authorised to pay such time costs and expenses on account of his remuneration and expenses pending the conclusion of the liquidation.”

Note: At a subsequent Creditors Meeting, Ken Fennell, of Kavanagh Fennell, 14 Pembroke Rd., Ballsbridge, Dublin 4 was appointed Liquidator.
