SEA POLLUTION (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS)
ACT 2006 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2006.

The Minister for Transport, Mr. Martin Cullen, T.D., has made the above Statutory Instrument.

This order provides for the commencement of Part 1, Part 3 and Part 4 of the Sea Pollution (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006.

The Sea Pollution (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006 amends the Sea Pollution Acts 1991 to 1999 to give effect to a number of instruments which have been agreed at the International Maritime Organisation relating to the protection of the marine environment.

Part 3 relates to the Protocol to the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Co-Operation 1990 (OPRC), the International Convention on the control of Harmful Anti-Fouling Systems 2001 (AFS Convention), Annex VI as added to the International Convention on the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL) by the Protocol of 1997, and the International Convention for the Control and Management of Ships' Ballast Water and Sediments 2004 (BWM Convention).

Part 4 amends the Harbours Act 1996 (No. 11 of 1996) to provide that port companies and harbour authorities shall enjoy immunity from proceedings for the recovery of damages in respect of injury to persons, damage to property or other loss alleged to have been caused by a failure to perform or to comply with any of their functions with regard to the licensing of the storage of petroleum spirit under the Dangerous Substances Act 1972 (No. 10 of 1972).

The purpose of these Regulations is to give effect to EU Directive 2001/86/EC of 8 October, 2001, "Supplementing the Statute for a European Company with Regard to the Involvement of Employees".

The European Company Statute is a new legal instrument that gives companies with commercial interests in more than one Member State the option of forming a European Company (to be known as Societas Europea, "SE"), the objective of which is to make it easier for such companies to operate across the EU.

These Regulations transpose the provisions of the Directive, providing that a new SE cannot be registered without first negotiating with employees on their involvement in the Company, whether through information and consultation and/or, in certain circumstances, participation at board level.

NOTICE TO IMPORTERS, DISTRIBUTORS AND
RETAILERS OF CIGARETTE LIGHTERS

Concerning the European Commission Decision relating to the Prohibition on the Placing of Certain Cigarette Lighters on the Market.

The Commission Decision 2006/502/EC requires Member States to take measures:

- to ensure that only lighters which are child resistant are placed on the market.
- to prohibit the placing on the market of novelty lighters.

The Commission Decision, under Article 13 of Directive 2001/95/EC General Product Safety Directive was taken on 11th May, 2006 and published in the Official Journal on 20th July, 2006. (This text annuls and replaces the Commission Decision 2006/498/EC published in the Official Journal on 19th July, 2006 and in *Iris Oifigiúil* on 24th November, 2006.)

From 12th March, 2007, the Office of the Director of Consumer Affairs, in co-operation with the Customs Authorities will prohibit novelty lighters and lighters that are not child resistant from being placed on the Irish market. The Director of Consumer Affairs is empowered to issue a direction to any operator found not to be complying with the Commission Decision. Any person who fails to comply with such a direction would be guilty of an offence and would be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding €3,000 and/or imprisonment for 3 months.
