DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES (RETAIL AND PRIVATE PETROLEUM STORES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006.

These Regulations extend, until 31 December, 2008, the authority to license in certain circumstances petrol stations which were constructed before 28 September, 1979.

EARNINGS ADJUSTMENT FACTOR FOR THE YEAR OF ASSESSMENT 2007.

I, Brian Cowen T.D., Minister for Finance, hereby designate the average change in the average weekly earnings of industrial workers in all industries in the first half of 2006 as compared to the same period in 2005, based on the latest available data published by the Central Statistics Office, as the earnings adjustment factor to be used for the year of assessment 2007 for the purpose of:

- (i) the formulae specified in the definitions of “standard fund threshold” and “personal fund threshold” set out in section 787(1) of the Taxes Consolidation Act 1997, as amended, and
- (ii) the formula specified in section 790A(2) of the Taxes Consolidation Act 1997, as amended.

On this basis, the earnings adjustment factor for these purposes for the year of assessment 2007 is 1.033.
