MISUSE OF DRUGS (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT)

The effect of this Order is to exempt from the provisions of Section 3 of the Misuse of Drugs Act, 1977 (*which makes the possession of controlled drugs an offence*) substances, products or preparations including those fungi of any kind or description, containing psilocin or an ester of psilocin (which are commonly described as “magic mushrooms”) in certain limited circumstances.
