EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (COSMETIC PRODUCTS)
(AMENDMENT No. 2) REGULATIONS 2006.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

The purpose of the Regulations is to update the law in relation to the manufacture, marketing and sale of cosmetic products by the implementation of Commission Directive 2005/52/EC.

The Regulations provide for an extension of the period during which certain hair dyes may continue to be used in cosmetic products. During this period, the additional information submitted by the industry will be examined by the EU Scientific Committee on Consumer Products (SCCP). In the meantime, the use of the hair dyes concerned continues to be permitted on a provisional basis subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in Schedule 3, Part 2 of the principal Regulations,

The Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Pat the Cope Gallagher, T.D., issued the following Policy Directive in relation to sea-fishing boat licensing:

POLICY DIRECTIVE 1/2006

This Policy Directive provides for the replacement of Sections A, C and D of Policy Directive 2 of 2003, as amended, an addition to Section F of Policy Directive 2/2003 and the replacement of Section A and B of Policy Directive 3 of 2004. The Policy Directive addresses two matters.

Firstly it addresses the need to avoid the transfer of capacity into the sectors of the fleet being targeted under the decommissioning schemes 2005-2007 by re-segmenting the existing polyvalent and specific segments of the fleet as follows:

- The segmentation of the polyvalent vessels (excluding the already ring-fenced potting sub-segment and the vessels with pelagic wet storage capacity) into two size categories, vessels less than 18 metres in length overall and vessels of 18 metres in length overall and greater.
- The ring-fencing of the scallop fleet within the specific segment and the polyvalent segment of the fleet. The ring-fenced scallop fleet will comprise of vessels that have carried out a scallop targeted fishing activity for at least 50 days at sea in the two and a half years to 30 June 2005.

Secondly, the Directive continues the moratorium on active pelagic track record to cover 2005.
