**PLEASURE CRAFT (PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES
 AND OPERATION) (SAFETY) REGULATIONS 2005.**

The above Regulations, which replace the Merchant Shipping (Pleasure Craft) (Lifejacket and Operation) (Safety) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 259 of 2004), provide for an increase from €127 to €150 in the fixed payment in lieu of prosecution, if appropriate, in relation to an alleged contravention of the Regulations.

IMO SOLAS/EU Marine Equipment Directive (MED) marked personal flotation devices are included under the definition of a “suitable personal flotation device” in these Regulations.

Otherwise, the new Regulations continue to provide for the existing national provisions governing the operation of pleasure craft including personal watercraft, including provisions relating to age restrictions, the carriage and use of personal flotation devices and restrictions on the use of alcohol and drugs.
