**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (ORGANISATION OF WORKING TIME OF PERSONS PERFORMING MOBILE ROAD TRANSPORT ACTIVITIES) REGULATIONS 2005.**

The Minister for Transport, having consulted with the Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, has made Regulations under section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972). The purpose of these Regulations is to give effect to Directive 2002/15/EC of 11 March 2002.

These Regulations transpose the provisions of Directive 2002/15/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 March 2002 on the organisation of the working time of persons performing mobile road transport activities. The Regulations apply to drivers and other mobile workers who are involved in road transport operations that are currently subject to EU drivers' hours and rest period rules, including own account drivers and agency drivers. Generally the Regulations apply to anyone that is required by EU rules to have a tachograph.

The effect of the transposition of Directive 2002/15/EC is to apply the maximum average working week of 48 hours to mobile road transport workers covered by that Directive. The Regulations also prescribe that the working time of such mobile road transport workers must not exceed 60 hours in any single week and contain provisions concerning minimum breaks and the amount of night work that can be performed.

The Regulations come into effect on 2 January 2006 and will supplement the drivers' hours rules by regulating the full working day of mobile road transport workers i.e. driving hours and time spent on other work related activities. Such mobile workers will be obliged to comply with the new Regulations as well as the existing EU drivers' hours rules.
