On 13th April, 2005, a draft order was laid before Dáil Éireann and Seanad Éireann concerning the Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000, and was referred to the Joint Committee on Education and Science. On the 17th May, 2005, the Joint Committee passed a motion to each of the Houses of the Oireachtas regarding the draft Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000 (Section 5) (Specified Period) Order 2005. Consequently, on the 17th May, 2005, Dáil Éireann and Seanad Éireann passed motions in approval of the draft order. On 20th May, 2005, An Taoiseach, Mr. Bertie Ahern T.D., signed an order in respect of the above in exercise of the powers conferred on the Government by section 5(5)(b) of the Commission to Inquire into Child Abuse Act 2000.

SPEED LIMITATION DEVICES IN MOTOR VEHICLES

The Minister for Transport, Mr. Martin Cullen, T.D., has made the following statutory instruments:

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (INSTALLATION AND
USE OF SPEED LIMITATION DEVICES IN MOTOR
VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2005.

These Regulations give effect to Directive 92/6/EEC as amended by Directive 2002/85/EC relating to the installation and use of speed limitation devices in certain motor vehicles. Specifically, the Regulations provide that goods vehicles over 3.5 tonne design gross vehicle weight and passenger vehicles having more than 8 passenger seats must be fitted with speed limitation devices so that their speed may not exceed 90 km/h and 100 km/h respectively.
