THOROUGHBRED FOAL LEVY REGULATIONS, 2005.

Horse Racing Ireland, the Statutory Body responsible for the horse racing industry, have made the above Regulations under Section 38A of the Irish Horseracing Industry Act, 1994 (as amended by the Horse and Greyhound Racing (Betting Charges and Levies) Act, 1999).

It is now considered appropriate to amend the rates payable under the Foal Levy scheme. The resultant changes to the rates payable represent an inflationary increase of 5.9% on the rates set out in the Thoroughbred Foal Levy Regulations 2000 (as amended by the Thoroughbred Foal Levy (Amendment) Regulations 2004.
