MACKEREL (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND
CONSERVATION) REGULATIONS 2006.

The effect of these Regulations is to prohibit fishing for, transshipment or having on board mackerel by Irish polyvalent vessels under 65 feet registered length in ICES sub-areas VI, VII, XII and XIV and divisions IIa (non EC waters) IVa, Vb (Community Waters), VIIIa, b, d and e, with effect from 27 January 2006. These Regulations also extend the closure period of the mackerel fishery for Irish polyvalent vessels over 65ft registered length until Sunday 5 February 2006.

POLYVALENT MACKEREL LICENSING
REGULATIONS 2006.
