COMMISSION FOR TAXI REGULATION

**TAXI REGULATION ACT 2003
 (TAMPER-PROOF LICENCE DISC) REGULATIONS 2006.**

The Commissioner for Taxi Regulation has made Regulations under the Taxi Regulation Act 2003 entitled above.

These Regulations provide that it is necessary to affix a tamper-proof licence disc to the front and rear windows of a small public service vehicle before a licence is granted or renewed.

This tamper-proof licence disc must be displayed in small public service vehicles in the manner specified by the Commission for Taxi Regulation and it is a contravention of these Regulations to remove or attempt to remove this tamper-proof licence disc. The Commission has the discretion to waive the requirement to display a tamper-proof licence disc on the rear window in relation to vehicles that are over 30 years old.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATIONS, MARINE AND
NATURAL RESOURCESEUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (HYGIENE OF FISHERY
PRODUCTS AND FISH FEED) REGULATIONS 2006.

On 30 June, 2006, Mr. Noel Dempsey T.D., Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, made these Regulations to give immediate effect to EC Directive 2004/41 and Regulations Numbers 178 of 2002, 852, 853, 854 and 882 of 2004 and 183, 2073, 2074 and 2076 of 2005 (EC Food and Feed Hygiene Regulations designed to better protect public health), in so far as concerns the production, processing, and distribution, exportation and importation of fishery products and fish feed (including additives).

Certain establishments involved in those businesses are required to register and be approved (following official inspection) in order to continue their operations which will be closely monitored for compliance with the law. Registrations and approvals, and enforcement generally of these Regulations, will be dealt with by the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources until the statutory Sea-Fisheries Protection Authority is established under section 40 of the Sea-Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Act 2006 (Act No. 8 of 2006).

Fees continue to be chargeable under the Regulations referred to in Regulation 17(b) of these Regulations until 31 December 2006, after which the fees chargeable will be set under Regulation 6(1) of these Regulations.
