**SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK
(CONTROL OF VIBRATION) REGULATIONS 2006.**

The purpose of these Regulations is to transpose Directive 2002/44/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 June 2002 on the minimum health and safety requirements regarding the exposure of workers to the risks arising from physical agents (vibration), the sixteenth individual Directive within the meaning of Article 16(1) of Directive 89/391/EEC of 12 June 1989 (O.J. No. L 177, 6.7.2002, p. 13).

These Regulations prescribe the measures to be taken to protect employees from the risks arising from vibrations owing to their effects on safety and health, in particular muscular/bone structure, neurological and vascular disorders. These measures create a minimum basis of protection for all employees coming within the scope of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005.

**SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK
(CONTROL OF NOISE AT WORK) REGULATIONS 2006.**

These Regulations transpose into Irish law the provisions of Council Directive 2003/10/EC of 6 February 2003 on the minimum health and safety requirements regarding the exposure of employees to the risks arising from physical agents (noise), the seventeenth individual Directive within the meaning of Article 16(1) of Directive 89/391/EEC of 12 June 1989 (O.J. No. L 183, 26.6.1989, p.1).

These Regulations identify exposure action and limit values at which employers must take measures to minimise the risk of exposure to employees. The Regulations also set out specific requirements for risk assessment and measurement of noise exposure, personal protection, employee training, information and consultation and health surveillance.

Transitional arrangements are set out for the application of the Regulations to seagoing vessels and also to the music and entertainment industry.
