SEA POLLUTION (PREVENTION OF POLLUTION BY
SEWAGE FROM SHIPS) REGULATIONS 2006.

The Minister for Transport, Mr. Martin Cullen, T.D., has made the above Statutory Instrument.

These Regulations give effect to Annex IV of the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from ships, adopted by the International Maritime Organization on 2 November, 1973 and as amended by its Protocol adopted on 17 February, 1978, and as further amended by the Marine Environment Protection Committee (MEPC) of the International Maritime Organization.

The Regulations apply to all Irish ships, wherever they may be, and to all other ships when they are in the territorial seas and inland waters of the State.

The Regulations prohibit and control the disposal of sewage into the sea in accordance with the type of sewage for disposal and the geographical location of the ship. They also provide for the availability of adequate facilities at ports and terminals for the reception of sewage.

Section 29 of the Sea Pollution Act, 1991 provides for penalties for breaches of these Regulations.
