TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on 3rd day of April 2006, one Peugeot 306 motor vehicle, bearing identification mark BLZ 8003 was sized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141(1) of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 139(6) of the Finance Act 1992.

(2) A notice under sub-section (1) shall specify the name and address of the claimant and, in the case of a claimant who is outside the State, the name and address of a Solicitor in the State who is authorised to accept service of any document required to be served on the claimant and to act on behalf of the claimant.
