### LAND PURCHASE ACTS

The Minister for Agriculture and Food in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 8 of the Irish Land Commission (Dissolution) Act 1992 (No. 25 of 1992) proposes to sell:

- (a) 1.760 Hectares or thereabouts of land in the townland of Cloonbrin, Co. Longford.

The Minister shall, so far as reasonably practicable, have regard to the desire of any smallholder whose holding is situated within five miles of the property to acquire an interest in the land. "Smallholder" as defined in the Irish Land Commission (Dissolution) Act 1992 means a person being the occupier of a holding which in the opinion of the Minister is not an economic holding.
