EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (ROAD TRANSPORT)
(RECORDING EQUIPMENT) REGULATIONS 2006.

The Minister for Transport has made Regulations under section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972). The purpose of these Regulations is to give full effect to Council Regulation 3821/85 of 31 December 1985 as amended by Council Regulation (EC) 2135/98 of 24 September 1998 and Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1360/2002 of 13 June 2002.

The Regulations establish a Card Issuing Authority and designate the competent authority responsible for the approval and control of fitters and workshops for the installation, repair and inspection of tachograph recording equipment.

The Regulations provide for the powers of authorised officers for enforcement and prescribe penalties for infringement.

The Regulations specify those operations that are exempt from the Council Regulation when engaged in national transport operations.

The Regulations provide for all other matters relating to installations, inspection and use of tachograph recording equipment and the use of tachograph cards and record sheets.

The Regulations came into effect on 20 February 2006 and revoke the previous Regulations set out in S.I. No. 393/86.
