LEGAL METROLOGY (TYPE APPROVAL)
REGULATIONS 2006.

I, Patrick Farragher, Director of Legal Metrology, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 14 and 16 of the Metrology Act 1996, have made an order entitled as above.

The purpose of these Regulations is to provide for conformity assessment procedures to be prescribed by the Director of Legal Metrology for instruments used in trade. These Regulations confirm and restate in a single statutory source the procedures for granting of type approval for measuring instruments comprising examination and evaluation of an instrument-type and the granting of a certificate for its use on the Irish market.
