I, Micheál Martin, Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), have made an order entitled as above.

The purpose of these Regulations is to give effect to EU Directive 2005/88/EC, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 December 2005, on Noise Emission in the Environment by Equipment for Use Outdoors. These Regulations also provide for certain types of equipment listed in Article 1 of the Directive, which would not be able to meet the stage II limits by 3 January 2006 solely for technical reasons, to still be placed on the market and/or put into service by that date.

ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS) (COUNTY OF FINGAL) BYE LAWS 2006

N2 FINGLAS — ASHBOURNE ROAD SCHEME

Fingal County Council at its meeting on 8th May, 2006 adopted and approved the Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Fingal) Bye-Laws 2006 in respect of the stretch of the N2 Finglas-Ashbourne Road Scheme which is in the administrative area of Fingal County Council.
