EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (QUALITY OF SHELLFISH WATERS) REGULATIONS 2006.

The Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Noel Dempsey, T.D., has made the above Regulations. These regulations prescribe quality standards for shellfish waters, designate the waters to which they apply, and require the preparation and implementation of action programmes in respect of all such waters. The Regulations give effect to Council Directive 79/923/EEC of 30 October 1979 on the quality required of shellfish waters and replace earlier Statutory Instruments Nos. 200 of 1994 and 459 of 2001.
