CHILD CARE (PRE-SCHOOL SERVICES) REGULATIONS 2006.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations set out the various requirements to be complied with by persons carrying on pre-school services for the purposes of securing the health, safety and welfare and promoting the development of pre-school children.

The Child Care (Pre-School Services) Regulations 1996 (S.I. No. 398 of 1996) and the Child Care (Pre-School Services) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 268 of 1997) are revoked by these Regulations.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT 2006 (COMMENCEMENT) (No. 2) ORDER 2006.
