SOUTH WESTERN FISHERIES REGION (PROHIBITION
OF THE USE OF PRAWNS, SHRIMP AND OTHER
CRUSTACEA) BYE-LAW NO. 810, 2006.

I, John Browne, Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962 (No. 31 of 1962)) of the Fisheries (Consolidation) Act 1959 (No. 14 of 1959), section 33 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1962, the Fisheries (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1977 (S.I. No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 307 of 2002)) and the Marine (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2006 (S.I. No. 82 of 2006), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the South Western Fisheries Region (Prohibition of the use of Prawns, Shrimp and other Crustacea) Bye-law No. 810, 2006.

2. This Bye-law comes into operation on the day of its making.

3. In this Bye-Law "South Western Fisheries Region" means the area described in column (4) of the First Schedule to the Fisheries Regions Order 1980 (S.I. No. 324 of 1980) opposite the reference in column (2) to the South Western Region at reference number 3 of that Schedule.

4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any person to—

- (a) use or attempt to use any prawn, shrimp or any other crustacean as bait to angle or take fish with rod and line, or
- (b) have in his or her possession prawn, shrimp or any other crustacean for use as bait with rod and line on or near the banks of the waters,

in the South Western Fisheries Region during the month of September in any year.

5. Article 4 does not apply in that part of the River Lee downstream of the weir in the city of Cork (the highest point to which normal tides flow) to the point where the two channels of the Lee converge.

6. The South Western Fisheries Region Bye-Law No. 751, 1998 is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law prohibits the use of any prawn, shrimp or any other crustacean as bait to angle or take fish with rod and line during the month of September each year in the South Western Fisheries Region with the exception of that part of the River Lee downstream of the weir in the city to the point where the two channels of the Lee converge. This Bye-law also revokes Bye-law No 751, 1998.

No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 307 of 2002)) and the Marine (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2006 (S.I. No. 82 of 2006), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the South Western Fisheries Region (River Lee) Bye-law No. 811, 2006.

2. This Bye-law comes into operation on the day of its making.

3. It is prohibited for any person to use or attempt to use any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks in angling for fish with rod and line in any year during the period from 30 April to —

(a) 30 September, in angling for salmon and sea trout, and

(b) 12 October, in angling for trout,

in that part of the River Lee downstream of the weir in the city of Cork (the highest point to which normal tides flow) to the point where the two channels of the Lee converge.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Bye-law and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

This Bye-law prohibits the use of any fish hooks, other than single barbless hooks in angling for fish with rod and line each year in that part of the River Lee downstream of the weir in the city to the point where the two channels of the Lee converge during the period from 30 April to 30 September, in angling for salmon and sea trout, and 12 October, in angling for trout.

No. 30 of 1977) (as adapted by the Marine and Natural Resources (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 307 of 2002)) and the Marine (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2006 (S.I. No. 82 of 2006), hereby make the following bye-law:

1. This Bye-law may be cited as the Western Fisheries Region Dawros (Kylemore) River Bye-law No. 812, 2006.

2. This Bye-law comes into operation on the day of its making.

3. It is prohibited for any person to—

(a) use any lure other than artificial fly in angling for any kind of fish with rod and line, or

(b) have in his or her possession any mounted rod to which is attached any lure other than artificial fly on or near the banks of the waters,

in that part of the Dawros River from where it flows out of Lough Maladrolaun (also known as the Rock Pool) in the townlands of Pollacappul and Mweelin to the bridge on the Letterfrack-Tullycross road in the townlands of Tooreena and Dawros More in the county of Galway.
