**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (APPROVAL AND  
REGISTRATION OF DEALERS OF BOVINE ANIMALS  
AND SWINE) REGULATIONS 2007.**

The Minister for Agriculture and Food has made Regulations under the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), entitled as above, dated 4 April 2007. These Regulations give effect to Council Directive 97/12/EC, amending and updating Directive 64/432/EEC on health problems affecting intra-community trade, in so far as it relates to dealers in bovine animals and swine. The Regulations regulate the operations of dealers and lays down their obligations and responsibilities in relation to the keeping of records and provision of information relating to their operations. A Dealer who buys and sells animals commercially either directly or indirectly, who has a regular turnover of these animals and who within a maximum of 30 days of buying animals resells them or relocates them from the first premises to other premises not within his/her ownership and who meets the conditions of Article 13 of the Council Directive.
