CONTROL OF FISHING FOR SALMON ORDER 2007.

The Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources Mr. John Browne, T.D., has made the above Order.

This Order authorises the issue of commercial fishing licences by regional fisheries boards and sets out the criteria under which those licences may be issued and prescribes the maximum number of commercial licences which may be issued by regional boards. The Order also provides for the allocation of licences that may become available in 2007 because a person who would be eligible to be awarded a licence accepts an offer from the hardship fund. The Order revokes the Control of Fishing for Salmon Order 2005 (S.I. No. 72 of 2005) and the Control of Fishing for Salmon (Amendment) Order 2006 (S.I. No. 653 of 2006).
