They provide for the free movement within the Community of certain instruments and set out essential requirements, which must be met for instruments intended for certain specified uses. The Regulations implement the provisions of the Directive relating to the following categories of instrument:

- Water Meters for Cold Water
- Gas Meters and Volume Conversion Devices
- Active Electrical Energy Meters
- Measuring Systems for the continuous and Dynamic Measurement of Quantities of Liquids other than Water.
- Automatic Weighing Instruments
- Taximeters
- Material Measures of Length
- Capacity Serving Measures
- Dimensional Measuring Instruments
- Exhaust Gas Analysers
