Part 3, section 29, amends subsection (2) of section 8 of the Oil Pollution of the Sea (Civil Liability and Compensation) Act 1988, as amended, to include salvage operations undertaken by the Irish Coast Guard in the list of parties not liable for pollution damage caused by ships in the State.

The Health and Safety Authority, in accordance with section 60 of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (No. 10 of 2005), and with the consent of, the Minister for Labour Affairs, Mr. Billy Kelleher, T.D. and following public consultation, has published a Code of Practice entitled "2007 Code of Practice for the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Chemical Agents) Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 619 of 2001)".

This Code of Practice provides practical guidance as to the observance of Regulations 4(1)(e), 4(5)(d), 6(1)(c) and 10(3) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Chemicals Agents) Regulations 2001, in relation to occupational exposure limit values (OELVs) for a number of chemical agents as listed in Schedule 1 to the code, having regard to the provisions of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005.

This Code of Practice comes into effect on Monday 27 August 2007, and from that date it replaces the "2002 Code of Practice for the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Chemicals Agents) Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 619 of 2001)" which was issued in accordance with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 1989.
