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SI 766 of 2007 entitled **European Communities (Cableway Installations Designed to Carry Persons) (Amendment) Regulations 2007** came into effect on the 24th November, 2007, notice of its making having been published in *Iris Oifigiúil* on 23rd November, 2007.

These Regulations made the Railway Safety Commission the competent authority for the purposes of complying with section 15 of the European Communities (Cableway Installations Designed to Carry Persons) Regulations 2003.

The explanatory note published on 23rd November, 2007, should have read:

“This order specifies in accordance with section 15 of the European Communities (Cableway Installations designed to Carry Persons) Regulations 2003, that the Railway Safety Commission is now the competent authority for the purposes of these Regulations. This designation is being made as the Railway Safety Commission is the body considered best placed to oversee the technical aspects of Cableway Installations in Ireland.”

No. 451 of 2003), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 528 of 2003), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 228 of 2005), the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 647 of 2005) and the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 376 of 2007).

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2007.
