THOROUGHBRED FOAL LEVY REGULATIONS 2006.

Horse Racing Ireland, the Statutory Body responsible for the horse racing industry, has made the above Regulations with the consent of the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism under Section 38A of the Irish Horseracing Industry Act 1994 (as amended by the Horse and Greyhound Racing (Betting Charges and Levies) Act 1999).

The Foal Levy Committee (comprising nominees from the Irish Thoroughbred Breeders Association, the Irish Farmers Association and Horse Racing Ireland) and the HRI Board have agreed to the annual application of inflationary type increases to the Thoroughbred Foal Levy to contribute to the increasing costs, level of services and funding requirements of the primary beneficiaries.
