BLUE WHITING (CATCH REPORTING) REGULATIONS
2007.

These Regulations specify catch reporting requirements for Irish sea-fishing vessels fishing for blue whiting. In particular, these Regulations require the master of an Irish sea-fishing vessel that is fishing for blue whiting to immediately notify the Sea-Fisheries Protection Authority by fax or telephone, if and when that vessel has caught and retained on board 500 tonnes of blue whiting and to further notify the Authority, if and when each additional quantity of 500 tonnes is caught and retained on board the vessel.
