EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (CLASSIFICATION,
PACKAGING AND LABELLING OF DANGEROUS
PREPARATIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007.

These Regulations amend Schedules 3, 4 and 7 to the European Communities (Classification, Packaging and Labelling of Dangerous Preparations) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 62 of 2004).

The Regulations transpose Commission Directive 2006/8/EC of 23 January, 2006, which amends Annexes II, III, and V to Directive 1999/45/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 May, 1999, on the approximation of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States relating to the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous preparations. Directive 1999/45/EC, as previously amended, is transposed into Irish law by the 2004 Regulations (S.I. No. 62 of 2004).

The aim of these Regulations is to protect human health and the environment from the harmful effects of dangerous preparations. The Regulations require each manufacturer, importer or distributor of a dangerous preparation to classify and label it according to its inherent hazards and to provide safety data sheets.
