EMPLOYMENT PERMITS ACT 2006 (PRESCRIBED
FEES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROCEDURES)
REGULATIONS 2006.

Mr. Micheál Martin T.D., Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment has signed the above Regulations, which provide for the implementation of the Employment Permits Act 2006, which came into effect on 1st January, 2007.

These Regulations permit certain foreign nationals to be employed in the State and set out the procedures to be followed in making an application for such a permit, including the form in which an application should be made and the review procedures to be followed in cases where application for a permit is refused or a permit is revoked. The Regulations also prescribe the maximum fees which must accompany an application for a new or renewal employment permit.

TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on the 25th day of May 2006, one motor vehicle bearing registration number G 642 TYT was seized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141 of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 102(6) of the Finance Act 1999.
