PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE CONSUMER INFORMATION (ADVERTISEMENTS FOR CONCERT OR THEATRE PERFORMANCES) ORDER 1997.

Micheál Martin T.D., Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, wishes to announce a public consultation on the Consumer Information (Advertisements for Concert or Theatre Performances) Order 1997.

The Order regulates the information on ticket prices and related matters provided in advertisements for public concert or theatre performances. Its main provision is that every written advertisement for a public concert or theatre performance must indicate the admission price of a ticket and, where applicable, must state separately the amount in monetary or percentage terms of any additional charge and the circumstances in which such a charge is payable.

The Minister would welcome the views of interested parties on the replacement of the present Order by a new Consumer Information Regulation and on a number of possible changes to the scope and substance of the current provisions. These include their extension to sporting and other events and a requirement to state ticket prices as a single amount inclusive of all fees and charges except discretionary charges for express postage.
