ENERGY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 2006
(COMMENCEMENT OF SECTION 19) ORDER 2007.

On June 14, 2007, the Minister for Communications, Marine & Natural Resources signed into law the above Order, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(2) of the Energy (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006 (No. 40 of 2006).

Section 19 of the Act provides for the designation, by the Commission for Energy Regulation, of a licensed supplier to act as a supplier of last resort, and a licensed shipper to act as a shipper of last resort, to supply gas to final customers of another licensed supplier or shipper (as appropriate) in certain specified circumstances. The provisions of this section are required as a consequence of full gas market opening which will take place on July 1st 2007.

SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK

NOTICE

The Minister of State at the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment has made the following Statutory Instrument:

S.I. No. 299 of 2007.

SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK
(GENERAL APPLICATION) REGULATIONS 2007.

These Regulations, inter alia, revoke and replace those provisions of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 1993 (S.I. No. 44 of 1993) (other than Part X and the Twelfth Schedule relating to the notification of accidents and dangerous occurrences, which remain in place) that were not already revoked under the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Amendment) (Revocation) Regulations 2005 (S.I. No. 392 of 2005) following their incorporation in the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (No. 10 of 2005). They also revoke the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Amendment) Regulations 2001 (S.I. No. 188 of 2001).

The Regulations also revoke and replace an additional 20 full sets and 4 part provisions of Regulations relating to occupational safety, health and welfare.

The revocations are supplemented by the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (Repeals)(Commencement) Order 2007 (S.I. 300 of 2007) which, in accordance with sections 1(2) and 4(2) of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (No. 10 of 2005) activates the repeal of sections 33 to 35 and 115 and 116 of the Factories Act 1955 (No. 10 of 1955) and sections 28 and 29 of the Safety in Industry Act 1980 (No. 9 of 1980).

The Regulations retranspose 14 EU Directives relating to occupational safety, health and welfare concerning various matters, including the workplace, the use of work equipment at work, the provision and use of personal protective equipment, the manual handling of loads, the provision and use of display screen equipment, work at height, the control of noise at work, the control of vibration at work, the protection of children and young persons, the protection of pregnant, post natal and breastfeeding employees, night work and shift work, the provision of safety signs at places of work and explosive atmospheres at places of work.

In addition, the Regulations modernise legal requirements concerning the safe use of electricity in the workplace and the provision of first-aid facilities at work.

Subject to the particular periods referred to in Regulations 9(2), 122, 134 and 160(2), the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 come into operation on 1 November 2007.
