No. 760 of 2005) so as to give further legal effect to Directive 2003/55/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the 26 June, 2003 concerning common rules for the internal market in natural gas by further clarifying the arrangements for unbundling the transmission systems and distribution systems currently operated by Bord Gáis Éireann.
