These Statutory Instruments transpose into Irish law the provisions of Commission Directive 2006/89/EC which adapts for the sixth time to technical progress Council Directive 94/55/EC on the approximation of the laws of the Member States with regard to the transport of dangerous goods by road.

The Statutory Instruments revoke and replace the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 405 of 2006); the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road) (ADR Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 406 of 2006); the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Act 1998 (Appointment of Competent Authorities) Order 2006 (S.I. No. 407 of 2006); and the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Act 1998 (Fees) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 408 of 2006).

The new Directive gives effect to the 2007 changes to the technical Annexes of the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR) which was made under the auspices of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE).
