3. The day and hour at which the poll in university constituencies shall be closed shall be the 24th day of July 2007, at 11.00 a.m.
4. This Order may be cited as the Seanad (University Members) General Election Order 2007.

2. The period during which the Seanad Returning Officer may receive nominations to the panels by members of the Oireachtas shall expire at noon on the 22nd day of June 2007.
3. The 26th day of June 2007 shall be the day on which the Seanad Returning Officer will sit for the completion of the panels and the place at which she will sit for the said purpose shall be Leinster House, Dublin 2.
4. The day on which the ballot papers shall be issued shall be the 9th day of July 2007.
5. The poll shall be closed at 11.00 a.m. on the 23rd day of July 2007.
6. The address of the Seanad Returning Officer to which nomination papers and other communications may be sent shall be Leinster House, Dublin 2.
7. The Order may be cited as the Seanad (Panel Members) General Election Order 2007.
