ELECTRICITY REGULATION ACT 1999 (TRADING ARRANGEMENTS IN ELECTRICITY) (REVOCATION) REGULATIONS 2007.

The Commission for Energy Regulation, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 9(1)(d) of the Electricity Regulation Act 1999 (No. 23 of 1999), the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources having given a direction to it under Section 9(1)(a) of the Act, and having taken into account the matters raised in the public consultation process carried out by the Commission under Section 9(1)(b) of the Act, and the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources having given his consent, has made the above Order, S.I. No. 723 of 2007.

These Regulations revoke S.I. No. 49 of 2000 from the 1st of November 2007. S.I. No. 49 of 2000 established the transitional trading arrangements and market rules. This provides for the Single Electricity Market (SEM), being a single competitive wholesale electricity market on the island of Ireland. The rules and procedures for an electricity trading and settlement system for the SEM are set out in the SEM Trading and Settlement Code established pursuant to section 9BA(1) of the Electricity Regulation Act 1999 and designated pursuant to these Regulations.

ROAD TRAFFIC (LICENSING OF LEARNER DRIVERS) (No. 2) REGULATIONS 2007.

These regulations provide that the amendments effected by Regulation 2(b)(i) and (iii) of the Road Traffic (Licensing of Learner Drivers) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 719 of 2007) to Regulation 17(6) of the Road Traffic (Licensing of Drivers) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 537 of 2006) do not apply, until 30 June 2008, to a person who holds or held a provisional licence for a category of vehicle in force at any time within the 5 year period before 30 October, 2007, where the person has a learner permit (provisional licence) in that category.

These regulations provide that a person who is granted a learner permit for a vehicle in category A, A1, M, W, B or EB by a licensing authority and has not previously held, within the period of 5 years prior to the granting, such a permit in that category, is not entitled to make an application to an Issuing authority for a certificate of competence within the period of 6 months from the day the permit comes into force.
