SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE AT WORK
(GENERAL APPLICATION) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2007.

The purpose of these Amendment Regulations is to remove ambiguity about the continued use of certain types of equipment, to provide better clarification of the technical requirements relating to portable equipment and to ease the possible burden and cost of compliance with inspection and testing of electrical installations.

In addition the Regulations correct an omission in the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 (S.I. No. 299 of 2007), compared to the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Control of Noise at Work) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 371 of 2006) in relation to health surveillance associated with the control of noise at work, clarify the requirements regarding the testing, as part of a thorough examination, of certain lifting equipment, and correct some errors in the text of S.I. No. 299 of 2007.

These Regulations come into operation on 12 November, 2007.
